Corona Virus (COVID-19)**

Dear Sadh Sangat Jee,

To assist with maintaining SA Health social distancing requirements please observe the following requirements when entering and leaving the Gurudwara Sahib:

***Darbar Sahib***

- Sit according to the markings on the floor to observe social distancing requirements.
- Do not go into Babaiji Sukhasan Room following evening Samapthi to ensure density COVID regulations are met.
- Do not crowd the Babaiji, Prashaad or Stage areas. Appointed Sewadars and Jathas only here please.
- Limit noise and gatherings after programs by promptly leaving, or on Sundays waiting quietly for Langgar Hall availability (see Langgar points below). This also ensures enough time for cleaning is available.

***Langgar***

- The tables and chairs, seating floor area, preparing, cooking and serving of Langgar will be in a manner that will adhere to COVID-19 regulations.
- Based on density requirements, the Langgar Hall can fit 80 - 100 people at 1 seating.
- The Langgar hall will open only when Sunday lunch is ready to be served.
- Entrance to the Langgar Hall will be via the door in the front foyer whilst the exit will ONLY be from the side entrance, next to the hand wash area.
- Once the Langgar Hall is at full capacity, the doors will be closed.
- Rest of the Sangat is encouraged to wait quietly upstairs in the Darbar Sahib/ foyer area and not crowd outside the Langgar Hall.
- Sangat is encouraged not to use the time to socialise but to have their Langgar and vacate the Langgar Hall as quickly as possible.
- Once the 1<sup>st</sup> seating finishes eating and leaves the Langgar Hall, tables and chairs, seating area will be sanitised and set-up before the doors open again for the 2<sup>nd</sup> seating and then as required.
- Langgar will be “simple” (dhall/similar, rice, yoghurt, dessert).
- Langgar will only be cooked by the appointed Sewadaars who are trained to comply with COVID-19 regulations.
- The kitchen will not be open for general sewa at this time.
- Sewadars doing the serving, cleaning and washing up are trained to comply with COVID-19 regulations.
- COVID Marshalls will be in attendance inside and outside the Langgar hall and Sangat / Members are requested to abide by their instructions at all times to ensure the whole process runs smoothly.

The Management Committee thanks you for your cooperation and understanding in these times.
