- Host families may choose to engage the services of a Chef/ Caterer in Langgar preparations. The Chef/ Caterer is **required to prepare the Langgar at the Gurdwara Kitchen premises**, using the Gurdwara utensils and under the supervision of the MC Langgar Team.
